

Sanctuary Sound Engineer of Christ Church United Methodist

Position Purpose: To provide high quality leadership to the Audio / Visual Team (including audio and visual components) in the Christ Church United Methodist sanctuary worship experiences. This position enlivens the process of bringing, building, and sending to create transformational worship experiences that make disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world.

Position Responsibilities:

- Be present at 3 services Sunday mornings and “to call” the service
- Execute Sunday morning check-list
- Lead a team of audio / visual staff members
- Extra services, as deemed necessary by the Pastors and the Director of Music and Fine Arts
- Christmas Eve services
- Ash Wednesday service
- Holy Week Services (which may include Holy Thursday and Good Friday services)
- Easter services
- Availability for weddings and funerals
- Attend training sessions for improving existing skills
